WHEREAS: Horticulture is an art and science which can be practiced and enjoyed by every citizen; and

WHEREAS: Horticulture is the production and use of trees, shrubs, flowers, fruits and vegetables; and

WHEREAS: Horticulture stimulates a multitude of businesses, including townism, garden centers, nurseries, seed stores, flower shops and manufacturers; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Horticultural Society has been a leader since 1866 in promoting horticulture, which has greatly enhanced the physical beauty and spiritual life of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 15 through May 21, 1983, to be

HORTICULTURE AWARENESS WEEK

in Minnesota.
