WHEREAS: The NAHAM has developed a successful accreditation program and highlights contributions of deserving admitting personnel and awards scholarships to admitting personnel; and


WHEREAS: The success of hospital admitting departments could not have been achieved without the contributions and dedication of all admitting personnel;


