WHEREAS: Minnesota retail bakers consistently have sought to produce quality nourishment as well as a broad variety of appealing delicacies for young and old alike; and


WHEREAS: Minnesota retail bakers for decades have served our state not only as artistic, ingenious craftsmen but also as active, civic-minded citizens;

RETAIL BAKERS WEEK


in Minnesota.
