NOTICE OF FEDERAL USER FEES

The Minnesota Department of Agriculture, being a delegated and designated agency to perform official grain inspection and weighing services under the United States Grain Standards Act, hereby, in accordance with that act, establishes the following fees to recover the supervision costs assessed by the Federal Grain Inspection Service. These fees are assessed in accordance with those fees published by the Federal Grain Inspection Service and apply only to grains as cited in the United States Grain Standards Grain Act. These fees are separate from the fees established by the Minnesota Department of Agriculture for inspection, sampling, and weighing services, and are subject to adjustments as prescribed in future publications of the Federal Register.

REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 123

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, 1982, Section 16.125, the following reorganization order is made with the prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and avoid duplication of effort in the operation of state government, the Business Development Division and three administrative positions of the Department of Energy, Planning and Development with all their powers, authorities, functions, and funding are transferred to the Department of Commerce.

The following positions and incumbents, with all accrued benefits and at their current salary levels are transferred from the Department of Energy, Planning and Development to the Department of Commerce. The legislative complement of the Department of Energy, Planning and Development is decreased by 25 positions and the legislative complement of the Department of Commerce is increased by 25 positions.
