



CERTIFICATE OF RESULTS OF  
SPECIAL BALLOT VOTE MARCH 8, 1983

I, Diana Skelly the Clerk of the Town of Bass Brook, County of Itasca, State of Minnesota do hereby certify that the results of the special BALLOT vote taken at the ANNUAL TOWN MEETING held in the Town of Bass Brook on Tuesday, March 8, 1983 on the question of whether or not the Town of Bass Brook shall exercise the powers, duties and authorities provided in Minnesota Statutes Chapter 368 and related statutes, more commonly referred to as URBAN TOWNSHIP POWERS do herewith certify that there were forty-eight (48) votes in favor of this question and four (4) votes against and that the Bass Brook Town Board of Supervisors met as a canvassing board and declared the results of the vote as above on the 9th day of March, 1983.

Prior to the Annual Town Meeting it was determined that the Town of Bass Brook qualified for URBAN TOWNSHIP POWERS under Minnesota Statutes 368.01 Subdivision 1A and other related statutes based on the 1980 census figures which indicate that the population of the Town of Bass Brook is 1859.
