WHEREAS: Agriculture is recognized as "America's Heartbeat"; and

WHEREAS: Agriculture employs more than 22 percent of the nation's workforce, and in Minnesota approximately one-third of our citizens derive their income from the production, processing, transportation and marketing of agricultural products; and

WHEREAS: Twenty percent of the United States' gross national product reflects expenditures for agricultural products; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's food and fiber industries provide about 40 percent of our state's gross economic products; and

WHEREAS: It is important that all Minnesotans understand how agriculture affects their lives and how a prosperous agricultural industry greatly benefits their well being;



AGRICULTURE WEEK


in Minnesota, and urge all Minnesota citizens, both rural and urban, to foster a better understanding of agriculture as one of the bounties and strengths of our nation.
