



Proclamation

WHEREAS: June 8 marks the one hundred sixty-ninth anniversary of General Andrew Jackson's victory at the Battle of New Orleans; and

WHEREAS: That battle was a sterling example of American determination to defend their Country and their Freedom; and

WHEREAS: It is meet and salutary for Minnesotans today to recall the courage and patriotism of their forefathers who upheld these principles and to emulate the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, June 8, 1983, to be

BATTLE OF NEW ORLEANS DAY

in Minnesota, and I call upon all citizens to mark this day with appropriate ceremonies and observances.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-three, and of the State the one hundred twenty-fifth.
