



Proclamation

WHEREAS: It is known with what a great diligence and perseverance of purpose FRIENDS OF ANIMAL ADOPTIONS, INC., has pursued its animal welfare objectives; and

WHEREAS: FRIENDS OF ANIMAL ADOPTIONS seeks, and has sought, improved facilities and wider support for the abandoned, strayed, lost, unwanted or abused animals whose fate places them under the care and protection of FRIENDS' ANIMAL ARK in Rosemount, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Such animal services as are assayed by FRIENDS OF ANIMAL ADOPTIONS--protection, health care and placement (adoption)--are of recognizable value to both their animal charges and the citizenry at large; and

WHEREAS: Such rewarding enterprise is encouraged, and of right and good favor should prosper in ever-growing recognition; and

WHEREAS: FRIENDS OF ANIMAL ADOPTIONS' sphere of influence has reached well beyond its immediate site in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: FRIENDS OF ANIMAL ADOPTIONS, INC., aspired to providing the best possible care in the best possible facilities for its animal residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, August 6, 1983, to be
