WHEREAS: The National Mothers of Twins Club was organized in Canton, Ohio, in 1960; and

WHEREAS: The St. Croix Valley Mothers of Multiples was organized in Forest Lake, Minnesota, in 1976; and

WHEREAS: The purpose of MOTC is to broaden the understanding of those aspects of child development and rearing which relate to multiple birth children; and

WHEREAS: This is accomplished through interchange of information among parents, educators, doctors and others with a direct interest and appropriate experience; and

WHEREAS: There are now 302 member clubs in 47 states and the District of Columbia representing more than 9,229 members; and


