WHEREAS: Nurses comprise the largest segment of our state's health care professionals; and

WHEREAS: Nurses are continually working to upgrade the quality of care given to the people of our state; and

WHEREAS: Nurses are expanding their professional health care role by increased education, research and practice; and

WHEREAS: Nurses are making their voices heard in our state's health care organizations and are working to obtain needed legislation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, May 6, 1983, to be

NURSES' DAY

and the week of May 1 through May 7, 1983, to be

NURSES' WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to join in this observance and participate in a demonstration of recognition and support of the leadership being exercised by nurses to gain optimum health for all citizens.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand, nine hundred and eighty-three, and of the State the one hundred twenty-fifth.
