WHEREAS: ROTC graduates from the State of Minnesota have served and are serving with dedication and distinction as members of the Armed Forces, and carry with them valuable abilities that me them leaders in other professional and community settings as well;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, May 7, 1983, to be

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to be mindful of the service, dedication and purpose of ROTC in the life of our nation.
