



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The week of April 24-30, 1983 has been proclaimed National Consumers' Week; and

WHEREAS: Each of us, as a consumer, makes daily decisions which affect our personal economy and ultimately the economy of our community, state and nation; and

WHEREAS: Wise purchase decisions must be based upon clear and meaningful product information provided by the producer or retailer of goods and services; and

WHEREAS: Consumers are entitled to safe, effective products and services honestly sold and the prompt redress of consumer grievances;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 24 through April 30, 1983 to be

CONSUMERS' WEEK

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I call upon all citizens to participate in this observance in a manner consistent with their role: consumers to make a particular effort to make wise, informed purchase decisions; manufacturers to give extra attention to quality control and clear, complete product use information; retailers and advertisers to devise advertisements for goods and services which are informational or educational as well as strictly promotional; and educators to structure sound consumer training into curricula for students at all levels.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-three, and of the State the one hundred twenty-fifth.
