WHEREAS: The 1983 annual meeting is expected to attract 150 Hispanic businesspersons from throughout the state of Minnesota;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State, do hereby proclaim Saturday, April 16, 1983 to be
