WHEREAS: It is fitting to pay special tribute to older Minnesotans' past and potential contributions to society and accord them special thanks for efforts that have yielded our present well-being; and

WHEREAS: Providing opportunities that will bring continued meaning to the lives of older people is of utmost importance in a society that itself is aging; and

WHEREAS: Closer bonds between the young, middle-aged and older generations must be strengthened so that intergenerational action can meet the challenges which lie ahead;
