WHEREAS: Project Concern of Minnesota, Inc., has promoted community involvement in Minnesota for 16 years; and

WHEREAS: Project Concern of Minnesota, Inc., shall set aside the week of April 25 through April 30, 1983, to promote the Walk for Mankind and educate the community in the problems of poverty and
