WHEREAS: The Hill-Murray High School Pioneers Hockey Team is dedicated to the high standards of athletic excellence, fair play, sportsmanship, and competition as set forth by the Minnesota State High School League; and

WHEREAS: In 1982-83, the Hill-Murray Hockey Team won the St. Paul City Conference Championship for the sixth consecutive year; and

WHEREAS: In 1983, the Hill-Murray Hockey Team won the Twin Cities. Championship for the fourth time in six years; and

WHEREAS: In 1983, the Hill-Murray Hockey Team won the Section III Championship, thereby gaining a berth in the State High School Hockey Tournament for the seventh time in nine years; and

WHEREAS: The Hill-Murray Hockey Team is the 1983 State High School Hockey Champion, earning the honor as the best team in the State of Minnesota; and
