

AMENDMENT TO THE ORDER DATED APRIL 8, 1983,  
IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE  
HONORABLE KERMIT J. LINDMEYER, JUDGE OF SCOTT  
COUNTY, FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT, STATE OF  
MINNESOTA, FOR RETIREMENT PURSUANT TO THE


WHEREAS, the physical incapacity of said Judge Kermit J. Lindmeyer has been attested to by Dr. Donald J. Abrams, Shakopee, Minnesota, and verified by Dr. V. J. P. Lundquist, Minneapolis, Medical Consultant to the Minnesota Department of Health; and

WHEREAS, the said Judge Kermit J. Lindmeyer has served as Judge of Scott County since July 1, 1971; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned Governor of the State of Minnesota has in April, 1983, made the determination according to law that the said Judge Kermit J. Lindmeyer has become permanently unable to perform his judicial duties.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1981, Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Kermit J. Lindmeyer, Judge of Scott County, First Judicial District, State of Minnesota, to become effective at the close of business on May 31, 1983. He shall become entitled thereafter to receive such disability retirement benefits as are provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1981, Chapter 490. I hereby direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota,  
acting pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1981, Chapter 490, do  
hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Kermit J. Lindmeyer,

thereafter to receive such disability retirement benefits as are provided under
