



Proclamation


- WHEREAS: The Beef Industry is one of the most important segments of Minnesota's economy; and

- WHEREAS: May is Beef Month is an appropriate time to honor Minnesota's Beef Industry;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the observance of
