- WHEREAS: Dance lovers of Minnesota desire a time to celebrate and dance; and
- WHEREAS: The importance of dance in Minnesota is indicated by its increasing audiences; and
- WHEREAS: Dance makes a significant contribution to the cultural and economic well-being of Minnesota and
- WHEREAS: From May 2nd through May 8th Minnesota's Dance Teachers and Ballroom Operators will host National Dance Week;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 2 through May 8, 1983, to be
