WHEREAS: Minnesota's economic well-being is tied increasingly with that of other nations; and

WHEREAS: Growing requirements and shortages of food, energy and other basic commodities demonstrate the interdependence and the need for cooperation among nations in the use and development of our planet's resources; and

WHEREAS: Exports of our agricultural and industrial products and services will contribute importantly to the growth and health of Minnesota's economy and provide additional investment and job opportunities for our citizens; and

WHEREAS: Minnesotans welcome the opportunity to compete successfully in world markets which contribute to our strength, vitality and well-being;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 15 through May 21, 1983, to be

WORLD TRADE WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge citizens to become more aware of the efforts of businesses, labor, agriculture, education and civic groups to promote international trade and understanding for the benefit of our state and nation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fifteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-three, and of the State, the hundred twenty-fifth.
