



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Technology-based business and government activity can improve the quality of Minnesota's economic and social environment; and

WHEREAS: There is a direct relationship between the condition of a state's educational system and the development and maintenance of technology enterprises; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's technology-based companies have provided a strong source of jobs and income for the state; and

WHEREAS: Technology-intensive companies within the manufacturing sector in 1980 accounted for wages, salaries and proprietors' income in excess of four billion dollars in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The seedbed for the emergence of similar companies in the future must be nurtured and cultivated if this record of accomplishment is to continue;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, May 10, 1983, to be

HIGH TECHNOLOGY DAY

in Minnesota.
