98,792 private enterprises; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota businesses with fewer than 20 employees employ more than 85% of the state's

work force; and

From 1969 - 1976, businesses with fewer than 500 employees generated 86.7% of all new jobs nationwide with 66% of employment growth from businesses with 20 or fewer employees

WHEREAS: 50% of all inventions, innovations and patents are developed by small businesses; and

WHEREAS: The growth and prosperity of Minnesota's small business is essential to the economic

well being of our state;
