- WHEREAS: It has been the custom of the State of Minnesota since 1935 to be represented by "Miss Minnesota" in the Miss America Pageant held annually, in Atlantic City, New Jersey, for the selection of "Miss America"; and
- WHEREAS: The Miss Minnesota Pageant, for the selection of "Miss Minnesota" has been held in Austin, Minnesota for the past seventeen years; and
- WHEREAS: The Miss Minnesota Scholarship Program, Inc. has established the dates of June 12 through June 18, 1983, as the dates for holding the 1983 Miss Minnesota Pageant which will be held in Austin, Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The 1969 Minnesota Legislature by concurrent resolution has formally recognized this annual pageant established in 1935 by designating the reigning Miss Minnesota, Laurie Sarrinen, her successors to be selected in the future, as the official "Miss Minnesota"; and
- WHEREAS: It is desirable that said pageant receive the utmost public support and recognition throughout the State of Minnesota,
