WHEREAS: We look to the mother in the home as the family bond, inspiring in children the importance of morals and ethics, and the fundamental laws which govern true integration and opportunity and to impress upon them the timeless values of all the civic virtues which are the requisites of good American citizenship; and

WHEREAS: It is appropriate that we designate one day in the year to pay tribute to the reverence which we hold the mother as the equal partner in the family in American Society;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, May 1983, to be
