



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Women's American ORT (Organization for Rehabilitation through Training) has pledged itself anew to expanding the worldwide ORT system; to doubling the ORT-Israel network; to confronting and defeating anti-Semitism everywhere it appears and in every guise it assumes; to backing Soviet Jewry and Human Rights all over the world; to supporting the people of Israel in their search for peace and security; to expanding the new Bramson ORT Technical Institute in New York City, as a model "breakthrough-in-education" school for the entire country, and to advancing the cause of quality public education with special emphasis on revitalized vocational and technical education throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS: Women's American ORT, the largest membership group in the 40-nation ORT family, has pledged itself once again -- as ORT moves into its 103rd year of belief in "education power" -- to enroll tens of thousands of new members in order for the organization to achieve its goal of relevant, high-caliber education necessary for democratic society;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, April 29, 1983, to be
