WHEREAS: Public Works services provided in our communities are an integral part of our Citizens' everyday lives; and

WHEREAS: The support of an understanding and informed citizenry is vital to the efficient operation of public works systems and programs such as water, sewers, streets and highways, public buildings, solid waste collection and snow removal; and

WHEREAS: The health, safety and comfort of Minnesota greatly depends upon these facilities and services; and

WHEREAS: The quality and effectiveness of these services, as well as their planning, design and construction, is dependent upon the efforts and skill of public work officials; and

WHEREAS: The efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff public works departments is influenced by the people's attitude and understanding of the importance of the work they perform;
