WHEREAS: Today's children are the brightest hope for our future; and

WHEREAS: Our world is often beset by complex problems which can directly -- and often adversely -- affect the lives of these children; and

WHEREAS: Children who are not fortunate enough to live in a nurturing environment frequently are not able to reach their fullest potential; and

WHEREAS: They may not have the healthy bodies, alert minds, education and skills so necessary to cope with the unforeseeable pressures of tomorrow's world; and

WHEREAS: All of us are obligated to do the utmost in our power -- as individuals and groups -- to see that all of these children receive the help they need to become productive and responsible adults;
