



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The high technology/data processing industry is deeply involved in furthering the development of the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: High technology/data processing companies contribute significantly to the economy of, and are a major employer for, the State of Minnesota and its citizens; and
- WHEREAS: High technology/data processing education is an area of major commitment for these companies and for schools, colleges and universities in the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Three professional organizations, the Data Processing Management Association, Association of Computing Machinery and Association of Systems Management, promote the interests of the industry and the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The objectives of these organizations and the high technology/data processing industry will be achieved by the upcoming 20th annual Northwest Computer Vendor Show and 5th annual Minnesota Joint Computer Conference; and
- WHEREAS: These two events, known jointly as UPDATA '83, will bring together approximately 100 major Minnesota companies, 150 exhibits and 6,000 professional data processing and corporate management personnel;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota; do hereby proclaim Wednesday, May 11 and Thursday, May 12, 1983 to be
