



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The leading cause of accidental death for all children after their first few critical days of life is from injuries received in automobile accidents; and
- WHEREAS: Hundreds of additional children receive debilitating injuries such as brain damage, epilepsy and paraplegia; and
- WHEREAS: The families of automobile accident victims suffer both emotional and economic trauma as a result of these unnecessary deaths and injuries; and
- WHEREAS: Most accidents can be avoided and death and injuries reduced through parental vigilance and added protective measures; and
- WHEREAS: Recognizing this serious health problem the Minnesota legislature passed into law the Minnesota Child Passenger Protection Act; and
- WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is engaged in a comprehensive educational campaign to inform parents of this law and of the hazards involved;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 1983, to be

CHILD AUTO SAFETY MONTH
