- WHEREAS: Minnesota Job Service has made significant contributions to the maintenance and expansion of the economy of the state of Minnesota and to the employment and job training needs of its citizens; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota Job Service has diligently provided services to both job seekers and employers by matching job openings with qualified workers; and
- WHEREAS: Experienced Job Service professional personnel demonstrate awareness of community resource understanding of the local economy and knowledge of the needs of the unemployed; and
- WHEREAS: Job Service offers testing and assessment of skills, career planning, counseling, and job placement, working with community based resources to broaden services and opportunities for all citizens of this state; and
- WHEREAS: Job Service provides Minnesota's largest inventory of job opportunities, here and throughout the country, placing more than 110,000 people in jobs every year; and
- WHEREAS: Throughout its history, Job Service has served Minnesotans during depression, war and cycles of plenty and recession, responding to demands of new technology while retaining a concern for the disadvantaged; and
- WHEREAS: 1983 marks the fiftieth anniversary of the signing of the Wagner-Peyser act which established Job Service;
