WHEREAS: Children are our most precious resource and the future of our society; and

WHEREAS: Responsibility for the personal and public safety of our children rests with every citizen within our society -- parent and non-parent alike; and

WHEREAS: The 4th of July weekend is often considered to be one of the most dangerous of the year for children because fireworks -- legal and/or illegal -- are an added element in the cause of accidents involving children; and

WHEREAS: Greater care in controlling the hazardous and unsafe use of fireworks is the responsibility of every man, woman and child; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the weekend of July 1 - 4, 1983, to be

CHILDREN'S SAFETY WEEKEND

in Minnesota, and urge all Hoosiers to regard the safety of children as a constant and integral part of daily responsibility.
