REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 125**

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1982, Section 16.125, the following administrative reorganization is made with the prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and in order that the state may benefit from an integrated program for the effective protection and employment of its resources, the authority of the Minnesota Environmental Quality Board to employ staff or consultants to work for the Board on a continuous basis is transferred to the State Planning Agency. The State Planning Agency shall provide staff support to the Environmental Quality Board as needed for the execution of the responsibilities of the Environmental Quality Board. Consistent with this transfer of authority, the following positions and their incumbents (including those transferred to the Environmental Quality Board in Laws 1983, Chapter 301), are transferred from the Environmental Quality Board to the State Planning Agency with all accrued benefits:
