

Proclamation

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has established the policy of State support for local planning and development of services designed to protect and improve people's health within their own community with the passage of the Community Health Services Act of 1976; and

WHEREAS: The Act focuses on programs designed to prevent disease, to promote health, to provide alternatives to institutional care, and to provide a community focus for citizens' efforts to be responsible for their own health; and

WHEREAS: State and local government officials and their citizen advisors are working cooperatively to develop and maintain an integrated system of community health services under local administration with State guidelines and standards; and

WHEREAS: The Community Health Services system will conduct their Sixth Annual Boards of Health Meeting, August 31 through September 2, 1983, to provide all participants in the system an opportunity to exchange ideas and develop plans for improving and enhancing the health of Minnesota's citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of August 28 through September 3, 1983, to be

in Minnesota and in recognition of the outstanding community development achievements of local government officials, advisory committee members and medical consultants in providing community health services in eighty-six Minnesota Counties.
