WHEREAS: In 1933, eighteen corrections professionals met and established the Minnesota Probation/Parole Association; and

WHEREAS: In 1958, the organization's name was changed to Minnesota Corrections Association to represent all types of correctional professionals and correctional services; and

WHEREAS: In 1983, Minnesota Corrections Association has grown to an organization of 650 members, involved in promoting legislation benefiting corrections, providing training and education to members and offering members access to publications, research reports and other material relating to correctional programs and practices; and

WHEREAS: The current membership comprises about half county and state field staff, one-fourth county and state institutional staff and one-fourth private agency staff, students and volunteers;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 26, 1983, to be
