

Proclamation

WHEREAS: The International Year of Disabled Persons -- in furthering the "full participation" in the national and community lives of 600,000 Minnesotans with disabilities; and

WHEREAS: This new momentum has drawn upon the initiative and resources of individuals and organizations in all sectors of our society working in partnership with disabled persons; and

WHEREAS: These partnerships have contributed substantially to progress in improving the lives of disabled Minnesotans; and

WHEREAS: Further action is required to increase public understanding of the still unmet needs of disabled Minnesotans; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota must continue and accelerate progress toward the long-term goals of and for disabled Minnesotans furthered during the International Year of Disabled Persons, through expanded educational opportunity; improved access to housing, buildings and transportation; greater opportunity for employment; greater participation in recreation, social and cultural activities; expanded and strengthened Rehabilitation Programs and Facilities; purposeful application of Biomedical Research aimed at conquering major disabling conditions; reduction of the incidence of disability through accident and disease prevention; increased application of technology to ameliorate the effects of disability; expanded international exchange of information and experience to benefit all disabled persons;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim 1983-1992 to be
