Cystic Fibrosis is the number one genetic killer of children and young adults in the United States; and

WHEREAS: 30,000 persons from infants to young adults are affected with Cystic Fibrosis, an inherited metabolic disorder of unknown causes; and

WHEREAS: Half of all children born with Cystic Fibrosis today will die before they reach 21 years of age; and

WHEREAS: There presently is no carrier test, no control and no cure for Cystic Fibrosis; and

WHEREAS: The Cystic Fibrosis Foundation is committed to lengthen and improve the quailty of life for CF patients and to reduce the impact of the disease on patients, families and society; and

The mission of the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation is to find the means for the prevention, WHEREAS: control and effective treatment through biomedical research and clinical studies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 18 through September 24, 1983, to be
