ORDER FOR ADJUSTMENT OF FEES

Pursuant to the authority vested in me under Minnesota Statutes, Section 16A.128 and 27.07, I hereby find the need for increasing fees and hereby order that the following fees be set for the inspection and grading of produce. These fees shall be effective on or after July 1, 1983, and are payable by the parties requesting this inspection service to the Commissioner of Agriculture pursuant to law.

Additional Inspection and Grading Issued on the Same Certificate	\$ 1.00
Overtime fee per hour, per employee assigned, is charged in addition to the inspection fee for all inspection hours worked after 5:00 p.m. and before 8:00 a.m., Monday through Friday, and for all hours worked on Saturday, Sunday, and state and national holidays.	\$ 7.50
Standby fee per hour if the produce is not available during the time period inspection services are requested	\$15.00
Inspection telegram fee per telegram	\$15.00
Additional copies of inspection certificate fee	\$ 2.25
Minimum inspection fee (not applicable for up to 20 bags of certified seed when delivered to the inspector)	\$10.00
Continuous operations inspection fee per hour in lieu of the hundredweight fee when continuing inspection services are requested and approved by the Department	\$15.00

Mileage fees per mile travelled for inspections are to be charged at the current private car rate plus indirect costs
