WHEREAS: The Six Hundred Fifty Irish American Organizations of the Irish-American Unity Conference have designated Sunday, September 25th, 1983, as "IRISH SOLIDARITY DAY" and have requested all Americans to unite with them at rallies in every State and City across the nation beginning with The Rally at Dag Hammerskjold Plaza, United Nations Building, New York City, at 2:00 p.m., Sunday, September 25, 1983; and

WHEREAS: The Irish American Organizations and community in Minnesota wish to unite with the National Irish American Unity Conference in the observance of "IRISH SOLIDARITY DAY", at a Rally to be held at the State Capitol Mall, St. Paul, Minnesota at 2:00 p.m., Sunday, September 25, 1983; and

WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota will be provided an opportunity to participate in a program of speeches, music, poetry and dancing expressing "PEACE AND UNITY WITH JUSTICE FOR ALL IRELAND.";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, September 25, 1983, to be
