

Proclamation

WHERAS: PEACE LINKS, an organization arising from the growing concern of middle American women about the danger of nuclear war, will hold PEACEDAY on Sunday, October 2; and

WHEREAS: PEACE LINKS: Women Against Nuclear War works to increase participation among women and families at the community, state and national levels on the critical issues of nuclear war, the arms race and alternative proposals to bring a world of peace; and

WHEREAS: PEACE LINKS and its Minnesota affiliate work through traditional community groups to help women learn more about these issues, express their concern, organize for action, affiliate with other groups, support leaders committed to ending the threat of nuclear war and human destruction, and educate their children toward involvement in the democratic process;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, October 2, 1983, to be

PEACEDAY

in Minnesota, and call upon all of our residents to join with me in supporting the aims, goals and programs of PEACE LINKS during this day and throughout the year for the benefit of all the people in our great state.

FURTHER, I call upon our citizens to join with me in learning as much as possible about nuclear weapons and arms build-up for issue-related discussion and attendant peaceful alternatives which are in the best interests of our society, the life of our state and that of each human being.
