

Proclamation

Medical judgement and careful evaluation have shown that adequate training of ambulance attendants and first-response personnel directly reduce the number of persons dying of critical medical emergencies; and

The State of Minnesota is served by almost 8,000 certified Emergency Medical WHEREAS: Technicians-Ambulance (EMT-A), 160 certified Emergency Medical Technicians-Intermediate (EMT-I), many of whom protect the public health as volunteer ambulance and first responders, and almost 500 certified Emergency Medical Technicians-Paramedics (EMT-P); and

The State of Minnesota has recognized the value of emergency medical technician training by authorizing the registration of Minnesota EMT's under the authority of the Minnesota Human Services Occupation Act; and

The skill and attention to duty of Minnesota's dedicated and competent volunteer and paid Emergency Medical Technicians more than justify recognition and public gratitude; and
