



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Homeowners in the State of Minnesota consume large amounts of natural gas, petroleum and electricity every year to heat their homes; and

WHEREAS: Minnesotans are spending an increasing portion of their incomes to pay their energy bills; and

WHEREAS: Most of the dollars spent by Minnesotans for natural gas, petroleum and electricity leave the State and, therefore, have a negative impact on the State's economy; and

WHEREAS: Widespread activities to increase and improve energy conservation in Minnesota homes can result in a 12 percent statewide reduction in energy use by the year 2000; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota, together with Minnesota businesses, utilities and cities have many programs and services available to help Minnesotans to improve the energy efficiency of their homes;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 23 through October 29, 1983, to be
