WHEREAS: That freedom has been defended and preserved in succeeding conflicts by the willingness of millions of men and women to risk their lives to defend that freedom; and

WHEREAS: These veterans, who answered the call and took up arms to defend their country, continued the service of those men and women of 207 years ago; and

WHEREAS: The services performed by Minnesota veterans has demonstrated their willingness to meet this ultimate challenge of citizenship; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper that a day be set aside to honor our veterans in Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby call upon all citizens of Minnesota to observe Friday, November 11, 1983, as
