



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *Reye's Syndrome is a Disease of unknown cause which usually afflicts youth, age 18 and under, and is one of the top ten killers among all children's diseases; and*

WHEREAS: *In 1982, 200 cases were reported to the Center for Disease Control, of which 66 were fatal. The Center for Disease Control estimates that the reported total was only about one-fourth of the actual number of Reye's Syndrome cases; and*

WHEREAS: *The National Reye's Syndrome Foundation - Minnesota Region, is working to inform the public about the symptoms of Reye's Syndrome and is raising funds to expand research and education on the disease;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of November 7 through November 13, 1983, to be

REYE'S SYNDROME WEEK

in Minnesota.
