WHEREAS: Minnesotans have historically placed great importance on a strong educational system; and

WHEREAS: Young people are Minnesota's most important resource; and

WHEREAS: Good Food is an absolute necessity in building sound bodies and minds of young students; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota School Lunch Program is dedicated to providing highly nutritious meals daily at reasonable costs to approximately 450,000 school children; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota agriculture is blessed with the ability to produce a wide variety and abundance of food with an economic value that approximates seven billion dollars;
