



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Liberal arts education in Minnesota's colleges and universities has contributed significantly to the cultural, scientific and business leadership of the state; and
- WHEREAS: The Association of American Colleges and Minnesota's project for Improving Public Understanding of Liberal Learning have undertaken a public education campaign designed to promote public understanding of the benefits of a liberal arts education; and
- WHEREAS: Hamline University is the oldest liberal arts college in Minnesota, having been established in 1854 at Red Wing; and
- WHEREAS: The alumni and friends of Hamline University along with Minnesota corporations and foundations have enabled Hamline to raise \$21,000,000 in capital, annual and deferred gifts during the period of its recent capital campaign; and
- WHEREAS: These funds are being used to support the liberal arts at Hamline University; and
- WHEREAS: Hamline University takes this occasion to pledge its continued service to the people of Minnesota by offering liberal arts education of the highest quality; and
- WHEREAS: The conclusion of the Campaign for Hamline will be officially celebrated at the Annual Christmas concert on December 4, 1983, at Hamline Church;
