WHEREAS: December 7, 1983, will mark the 42nd anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor; and

WHEREAS: This anniversary is a reminder of the vigilance and preparedness which our nation must maintain; and

WHEREAS: We owe a great debt to those members of our Armed Forces who lost their lives in that attack, and also to those who survived and aided in carrying our their duties in the ultimate victory;
