WHEREAS: Warm weather brings out bicyclists of all ages, and also brings the risk of dangerous bicycle accidents; and

WHEREAS: Many bicycle accidents can be avoided by adherence to traffic laws and safe bicycle driving practices; and

WHEREAS: Bicycling is a healthy, energy-efficient mode of recreation and transportation; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has an active bicycling population working to improve bicycle facilities and education and enforcement programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 6 through May 12, 1984, to be
