WHEREAS: Nearly everyone uses and depends on electricity every day; and

WHEREAS: Most users of electricity take for granted the benefits, but are unaware of common electrical hazards; and

WHEREAS: Some 1,100 die of shock or in electrically-related fires in this country each year; and

WHEREAS: Resulting property loss from 205,000 fires totals \$950 million; and

WHEREAS: Many of these electrical shocks and electrically-caused fires could be avoided if consumers were aware of common hazards that cause such shocks and fires;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February 1984 to be

ELECTRICAL SAFETY AWARENESS MONTH
