WHEREAS: Mental retardation is a problem which affects almost 6 million individuals in America today; and

WHEREAS: More than 100,000 mentally retarded children and adults live in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The most effective weapons for prevention and alleviation of mental retardation are public knowledge and understanding; and

WHEREAS: During the month of March, the Association for Retarded Citizens, Jaycees, and Jaycee Women are carrying on educational and fundraising campaigns;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of March 1984, to be

MENTAL RETARDATION MONTH

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I urge that the citizens of this state give full support of this effort to overcome mental retardation.
