WHEREAS: Public interest in education is at its highest level in at least two decades; and

WHEREAS: The citizens of Minnesota should have the opportunity to determine the purpose and future of their public education system; and

WHEREAS: The commitment of Minnesotans to public education is so strong that state aid to schools makes up the largest single share of the state budget; and

WHEREAS: Quality of life in Minnesota is directly related to its education system;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 13 through February 17, 1984, to be
